Although he spent the better part of Saturday calling harness races at Freehold and the Meadowlands, finishing work around midnight, he is energized. When he arrives at the rink, he will not be playing in a game, though. He puts on black pants, a striped shirt, and gets ready to have a new kind of fun.

The 58-year-old Warkentin is in his first year as a USA Hockey official.

Warkentin is no stranger to hockey. He grew up in Toronto and was starting to skate at the same age he was learning to walk. He played organized hockey in youth leagues, high school and college, and for several winters was on as many as four teams at the same time. As an adult, he continues to play hockey in recreational leagues.

But now Warkentin is enjoying another side of the sport. Earlier this year, at the urging of his wife, Warkentin completed an officiating class and is now a certified Level 1 USA Hockey official. He has worked 10 games so far, for ages 10-and-under (Squirt) and 8-and-under (Mite).

"It's quite challenging and intense," Warkentin said. "But being out there with the kids, and the game, it's just a lot of fun. It's high-octane fun.

"I've had nothing but pleasant experience so far. No parents have thrown rotten tomatoes at me yet."

Warkentin is paired with a more experienced official in each game as he gets more comfortable in his role. Unlike the NHL, which has two linesmen and two referees, these games are worked by only two officials.

"You've got to skate your tail off and know the rule-book inside and out," Warkentin said. "It's a team effort between two guys and you have to work together. It's really all

about positioning, but you need to hustle.

"The games I've watched experienced officials do, it looks like they're doing nothing. It looks like they're standing in one spot the whole game. It just comes with experience to be in the right position; to see what is going on and being in position to make the right calls. It's a real challenge, but it's a lot of fun."

Warkentin officiates mostly on Sundays because of his schedule. He drives up to an hour to get to the various rinks and has worked primarily travel league games.

"These kids are fast and they've got skill," Warkentin said. "You've got to be on your toes and laser focus for three 15-minute periods. It's a fast game and split-second decisions. You can't stop the game and ask to think about it. You have to see what you see and call it right away. It's kind of like the races, in a way. When I call races, I don't think, I react."

# CAL EXPO PICK 3 RULES

1. Any scratch in the first leg of a Pick Three is now a refund.
2. A wager with a scratch in the second leg creates a consolation pool.
3. A wager with a scratch in the third leg creates another consolation pool.
4. A wager with scratches in the second and third leg creates another consolation pool.
5. A consolation pool is the sum of all wagers that include the scratch(es) for that leg or legs. The winning combination for the consolation pool is a wager with the winner or winners of the non-scratch leg(s).

"Of course, you're going to make mistakes. The professionals make mistakes all the time.

But everyone here knows you're not only developing the players, you're trying to develop the referees. We're all in the same boat. You just have to be honest when you mess up. You apologize and move on."

Warkentin, who has a Level 2 USA Hockey coaching certificate and has helped at clinics in the past, would like to work his way up the officiating ladder.

"I'd like to challenge myself and do higher levels," Warkentin said. "You only get out of something what you put into it. I'm taking this seriously. This means a lot to these kids and their coaches and their parents. When I get my assignment, I can't stop thinking about it all week. I want to do it right.

"Even if I'm up at 6 a.m. after a late night working, I'm not tired. I'm excited. I can't explain it. When I get on the ice, there is something magical about it."

## PYLON RULE

(For Horses Racing Without Interference)

1. Going inside two (2) pylons and lapped-on at the finish: The offending horse will be disqualified and placed behind any lapped-on horses at the wire.
2. Going inside three (3) or more consecutive pylons: The offending horse will be disqualified and placed last.
3. If an unfair advantage is gained by going inside, over, or in-between one or more pylons in order to pass another competitor: The offending horse will be disqualified.

**The steward's discretion applies to all placement.**

## Vox Populi Award Gaining its Niche in History

Why has the name Seabiscuit endured for so many years and why did his story become a best selling book and popular motion picture? When people discuss the greatest horses of all time, you rarely hear Seabiscuit's name mentioned. Other than his victory over War Admiral in a match race and perhaps the Santa Anita Handicap, how many of his stakes victories can you name?

The reason Seabiscuit has become one of the most beloved horses of all time is far more about his popularity and his fascinating rags to riches story in the times in which he lived than his racing record.

If there was a Vox Populi Award in 1938, Seabiscuit most likely would have won a larger percentage of votes for that award than for Horse of Year, considering he won only six of his 11 starts that year, includ-

### CHRB Rule No. 1699

(b) A horse shall not interfere with or cause any other horse to lose stride, ground or position in a part of the race where the horse loses the opportunity to place where it might be reasonably expected to finish.

(c) A horse which interferes with another and thereby causes any other horse to lose stride, ground or position, when such other horse is not at fault and when such interference occurs in a part of the race where the horse interfered with loses the opportunity to place where it might, in the opinion of the Stewards, be reasonably expected to finish, may be disqualified and placed behind the horse so interfered with.

ing another match race against a horse named Ligaroti.

It was Secretariat's owner Penny Chenery who created the Vox Populi Award in 2010 to recognize the race-horse whose "popularity and racing excellence best resounded with the public and gained recognition for the sport." But remember, vox populi translates to "voice of the people," so the award, while recognizing race record, is mainly about popularity and the ability to touch people.

With this year's poll closing December 12, the candidates are Gun Runner, Ben's Cat, Patch, Songbird, Lady Eli, and Arrogate.

From a performance and talent standpoint, Gun Runner, Arrogate, and Songbird would stand far above Ben's Cat, Patch, and Lady Eli if this were for Horse of the Year. But many believe Ben's Cat, Lady Eli, and Patch have a much better chance of winning the Vox Populi Award. Ben's Cat was one of the most beloved horses in the history of Maryland and Pennsylvania racing, who

died less than a month after his well-deserved retirement at age 11, having won numerous stakes multiple times, including the Mister Diz Stakes six times and the Jim McKay Turf Sprint five times. And there is Lady Eli, who not only survived the dreaded killer laminitis, she returned to the races to win grade 1 stakes on both coasts in 2017 after getting beat a nose in last year's Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. She parted the racing scene after this year's Filly & Mare Turf, in which she tore open her leg during the race, but still tried to the end. And finally there is the aptly named Patch, who became one of the most popular horses in the country during the Triple Crown trail, competing and performing well despite having only one eye.

And that is why the Vox Populi Award in years to come may have a more profound effect on the Sport of Kings than the Horse of the Year title, simply because this is not an award of kings. It is the common folks' award that is born of the heart and not

## STARTER'S RULES

**1728. Starter's Control.** The starter shall have control over the horses from the formation of the parade until he gives the word 'go.' The starter shall report to the stewards any misconduct or violation on the part of the driver and may order any unmanageable or disabled horse declared (scratched) from the race with the concurrence of the stewards.

**1729. Starting the race.** The starter shall bring the horses to the starting gate as near one-quarter of a mile from the starting point as the track may permit, and shall endeavor to get all horses away in position and on gait. If a horse refuses to come to the gate, is unmanageable or liable to cause an accident or injury to any other horse or driver, it may be declared and all monies wagered on that horse shall be refunded.

**1730. Recalls.** The starter may sound a recall for only the following reasons: 1-A horse scored ahead of the gate; 2- There is interference prior to the word 'go' being given; 3-A horse has broken equipment; 4-A horse falls prior to the word 'go' being given. There shall be no recall after the word 'go' is given and any horse, regardless of his position or an accident, shall be deemed a starter from the time he entered into the starter's control unless dismissed.

Horses of the Year, as gifted as they may be, will come and go, but the stories that will live on through the decades will be mostly about those worthy enough in the eyes of the public to win the Vox Populi Award.

When we think of Vox Populi winner California Chrome, sure we think of his many accomplishments in America and Dubai, but it was his meteoric rise from humble beginnings in California-bred races and the formation of the impassioned Chromies fan club that will sustain his memory. He was indeed a horse of the people.

Sure, Vox Populi winner American Pharoah became the first Triple Crown winner in 37 years, but it was his kindhearted nature and accessibility to the public, as thousands were permitted to visit him and lavish

Has there been a horse in recent years who touched more people than 2012 Vox Populi winner Paynter, who not only miraculously survived near-death battles with colitis, laminitis, and surgery to remove an abscess from the cecum, he actually made it back to the races, he winning one race, placing in grade 1 and grade 2 stakes, and making it to the Breeders' Cup Classic.

His owner, Ahmed Zayat, who also owned American Pharoah, said of Paynter, "I just do not know how he survived. I can't explain it. I keep living this whole ordeal it in my dreams. ## C.H.R.B. BREAKING RULES

**1722. Breaking.** Should any horse break from its gait in either trotting or pacing, the driver shall:

(a) Where clearance exists, take such horse to the outside.

(b) Attempt to pull the horse to its gait.

(c) Lose ground.

**1723. Lapped-on Break.** The driver of a horse which has broken from its gait who has complied with the breaking rule shall not be set back unless a contending horse on his gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish.
