Veteran Bob Johnson Adds to impressive totals

"I'd been in a bit of a slump going into that night, so it was extra nice," Johnson said. "I'll tell you, winning never gets old."

Bob was asked to talk a little about each of the winners.

"To be honest, I was just hoping to get a check with Talkin Tootsie, because she had missed a few weeks. I thought she went a super mile to beat a very nice trotter in Pridecrest."

Franks Best is one of the most popular performers on the grounds and was picking up his second snapshot on the year while using his patented late charge. "No question, he's my all-time favorite. He just keeps on going at age 11, and he still has that desire to win."

Johnson has always been high on the Knittel's Hi Ho Silverheel's hombred Allmyx'sliventexas, who has a 1:51 4/5 mark that was set last year at Running Aces and is closing in on the \$100,000 earnings plateau.

"That was a solid group and I wasn't sure how things were going to shake out early, but Mooney was able to work out a great trip. I think this horse is really coming up to some big races."

who now looked like a beaten horse. There was no more to give.

But this is when a true champion shines, and Dr. Fager, amazingly, wasn't through yet. With his blood at a boil, he pinned back his ears and gave one final thrust. Although there was no push to his legs, which were still struggling to grab hold of the turf, Dr. Fager basically willed himself back in front, heading Advocator yet again. But the stubborn Advocator wasn't giving up either and tried to come back again. This time, however, Dr. Fager clenched his teeth and refused to let him. He crossed the finish line a neck in front in the solid time of 1:55 1/5. Fort Marcy kept plugging away, but could not get closer than third, with Tobin Bronze right behind in fourth, beaten 2 3/4 lengths.

In some ways, this may have been Dr. Fager's greatest performance, as he somehow found a way to win with all his weapons taken away from him, except his heart.

PYLON RULE

(For Horses Racing Without Interference)

1. Going inside two (2) pylons and lapped-on at the finish: The offending horse will be disqualified and placed behind any lapped-on horses at the wire.
2. Going inside three (3) or more consecutive pylons: The offending horse will be disqualified and placed last.
3. If an unfair advantage is gained by going inside, over, or in-between one or more pylons in order to pass another competitor: The offending horse will be disqualified.

The steward's discretion applies to all placement.

After the race, Tartan Stable owner William McKnight turned to Nerud and said. "John I've heard all my life about horses trying to win, and now I've seen it. I can't believe he kept fighting and fighting."

Graham Heagney couldn't believe it either. "If anyone had told me a horse could give Tobin Bronze that much eight and beat him I would have laughed in his face," he said. "But Dr. Fager is truly a great horse."

CHRB Rule No. 1699

(b) A horse shall not interfere with or cause any other horse to lose stride, ground or position in a part of the race where the horse loses the opportunity to place where it might be reasonably expected to finish.

(c) A horse which interferes with another and thereby causes any other horse to lose stride, ground or position, when such other horse is not at fault and when such interference occurs in a part of the race where the horse interfered with loses the opportunity to place where it might, in the opinion of the Stewards, be reasonably expected to finish, may be disqualified and placed behind the horse so interfered with.

Horse of Year two years later, winning his second Washington D.C. International as well as the United Nations Handicap and eventually was inducted into the Hall of Fame. He became the third future Hall of Famer to be defeated by Dr. Fager that year, following Gamely and Damascus.

Dr. Fager naturally came out of the United Nations a tired horse. He had given his all. With the Woodward Stakes coming up in only 17 days, it was too soon for Nerud to bring him back, and he decided to give the Doc some time to recover and point him for a farewell appearance in the Vosburgh Handicap, knowing racing secretary Tommy Trotter would assign him some staggering weight that would exceed anything anyone had seen in a long time.

And so, the great Dr. Fager was down to one more race; one final scene to play. We were all aware the Doc could put on a show like no one else, but we were about to find out he also knew how to bring down the curtain.

McCarthy traveling road to success

Andy McCarthy has spent the past several years rising through the ranks of North America's harness racing drivers, and the 31-year-old Aussie native is hoping to continue the trend when he returns later this month from his winter holiday.

McCarthy has seen his purse earnings increase annually since the start of 2013, reaching \$5.52 million in 2017. His campaign last season was bolstered by successes on the Grand Circuit, winning events including the Jugette with Caviart Ally and Spirit of Massachusetts with JL Cruze, as well as in state-restricted stakes. In fact, McCarthy won seven stakes worth at least six figures in 2017, compared to three in 2016 and one in 2015.

Additionally, last year he hit the board 33 times in races worth at least \$70,000, out of 63

STARTER'S RULES

1728. Starter's Control. The starter shall have control over the horses from the formation of the parade until he gives the word 'go.' The starter shall report to the stewards any misconduct or violation on the part of the driver and may order any unmanageable or disabled horse declared (scratched) from the race with the concurrence of the stewards.

1729. Starting the race. The starter shall bring the horses to the starting gate as near one-quarter of a mile from the starting point as the track may permit, and shall endeavor to get all horses away in position and on gait. If a horse refuses to come to the gate, is unmanageable or liable to cause an accident or injury to any other horse or driver, it may be declared and all monies wagered on that horse shall be refunded.

1730. Recalls. The starter may sound a recall for only the following reasons: 1-A horse scored ahead of the gate; 2- There is interference prior to the word 'go' being given; 3-A horse has broken equipment; 4-A horse falls prior to the word 'go' being given. There shall be no recall after the word 'go' is given and any horse, regardless of his position or an accident, shall be deemed a starter from the time he entered into the starter's control unless dismissed.

attempts, and did so with horses with double- or triple-digit odds in 15 of those starts. Six times he had the favorite, winning five. He failed to get a check only four times with horses at less than 6-1 odds.

"Every year has kind of gotten better and better," McCarthy said. "That's always my goal. It's a lot more fun driving the stakes horses than just the daily grind. I'd really like to get on the stakes circuit a little bit more and hopefully I can keep the drives I had last year and keep those horses on the right path.

"Hopefully now people are starting to trust me more with their good horses in the big-money races. If I can keep getting the job done more and more, hopefully it picks up from there.

I think that's the biggest thing. People need to see you as a big-race driver and not just a driver that can handle a good horse in an overnight race."

A chance meeting with trainer Noel Daley inspired McCarthy to leave Australia and head to the U.S. in 2007. In his third lifetime drive in the States, McCarthy piloted Daley's Took Hanover to a 1:49 win in the open at the Meadowlands. McCarthy now has 1,884 victories in North America.

"I've always said if it wasn't for Noel I wouldn't be here," said McCarthy, who teamed with Daley on stakes-winners Caviart Ally, Cool Cates, and Sortie last year.

"He was the guy early on that gave me a shot in the bigger races. He stuck by me and really put me on the map."

McCarthy is a third generation horseman. His brothers Todd and Luke, who raced in the U.S. in 2009, are successful drivers in Australia and his father John is a highly-regarded trainer.

The McCarthy family was selected by the Bathurst Harness Racing Club as its 2016 Gold Crown honoree.

(a) Where clearance exists, take such horse to the outside.

(b) Attempt to pull the horse to its gait.

(c) Lose ground.

1723. Lapped-on Break. The driver of a horse which has broken from its gait who has complied with the breaking rule shall not be set back unless a contending horse on his gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish.
