CAL EXPO HARNESS

How To Evaluate The Favorite

At most harness tracks the favorites win at least 40% of the time. [Cal Expo lowest at 37%] I believe that a good handicapper can show a profit betting favorites. The profit margin is small, however. But, betting favorites minimizes the tough losing streaks that are inevitable for long-shot or exotic bettors.

There is a downside. It's difficult to win a lot of money betting favorites. At many tracks, you can't make big bets without significantly lowering the odds. If you're going to try to win betting chalk, you have to bet tracks that have large pools. Tracks that would qualify are Meadowlands, Mohawk, Hawthorne, Yonkers, Northfield, Cal Expo, and Hoosier Park. At most of the other tracks, a chalk bettor would have to make smaller wagers. That's fine if you just want to make a few bucks and enjoy the races. Winning is a lot more fun than losing.

BACK STOCK

Looped, parked eighth to drop, followed fave out far turn, urged to narrow gap on rail rider. Steps back up, James returns.

HI FIDELITY

Shot from gate, yielded to quarter moving winner, chased, urged to save place. Luke's choice over 2 others. Finally back inside too.

LA MADAWNA DE ROSA

Moved from back 4th over, failed to sustain the bid. Looking for an undercard slice.

ALWAYSALITTLEMORE

2nd over near half, good lead up trip, urged, caught for show slot. Willie's back in the bike. Solid gimmick threat.

YESWELLNOMAYBE

No hurry early, along rail the trip, just fair late interest. Extra week off since.

NO GUARANTEES

Out before quarter to top, braked while untested to the lane, sped home confidently. Obvious threat to repeat.

If you're betting favorites, you probably should have some sort of minimum odds requirement. You could do some testing to see where your break even point is. Once the payoff drops below 3/5 odds, it's hard to justify the bet, in my opinion.

Here are some other things I can suggest to chalk bettors: Only bet inside posts, or any post that wins at least 10%. If you bet trotters, stick to classy trotters that rarely break stride.

Only bet favorites that are likely to leave the gate, or have an inside post and can go first over. Only bet horses that have shown some class. These general rules will help you hit a higher percentage of winners.

Another general rule I follow if I'm considering betting a favorite. I always ask myself, "Can this horse go first over and win?" If you're unsure about the answer, then the horse is probably not a good bet as the favorite.

CAL EXPO PICK 3 RULES

1. Any scratch in the first leg of a Pick Three is now a refund.
2. A wager with a scratch in the second leg creates a consolation pool.
3. A wager with a scratch in the third leg creates another consolation pool.
4. A wager with scratches in the second and third leg creates another consolation pool.
5. A consolation pool is the sum of all wagers that include the scratch(es) for that leg or legs. The winning combination for the consolation pool is a wager with the winner or winners of the non-scratch leg(s).

I mention this because sometimes we may bet horses because we think they may get a good trip. For instance, say you think that the 5 horse is going to set the pace.

And, you believe that the only other leaver will be the 1 horse. The 1 horse is in good enough form, but you like the horse even more because you think it may get a perfect pocket trip following the five horse. Now, let's say that a minute to post time, the 1 horse is 6-5 odds. Now ask yourself, "Can this horse go first over and win?"

You see, betting a horse because you think it may get a dream trip is not good enough if the horse is the favorite. I've bet 12-1 shots because I thought they might leave and get a trip. But with favorites, that type of thinking isn't good enough. Races don't always go the way we think they will. Sometimes horses that we didn't expect to go out for the lead, leave, and horses that we expected to leave, take back and race off the pace.

PYLON RULE

(For Horses Racing Without Interference)

1. Going inside two (2) pylons and lapped-on at the finish: The offending horse will be disqualified and placed behind any lapped-on horses at the wire.
2. Going inside three (3) or more consecutive pylons: The offending horse will be disqualified and placed last.
3. If an unfair advantage is gained by going inside, over, or in-between one or more pylons in order to pass another competitor: The offending horse will be disqualified.

The steward's discretion applies to all placement.

Race 4 News

If you bet on a favorite, that horse should be sharp enough to just pull out at the half, march first over and win. If you don't think it can do that, the horse isn't a good favorite.

If a horse has consistently faster final times than the other horses in the race, this can be the surest bet in racing.

Sometimes I hear people put horses down, saying things like, that horse isn't game, or, it has no heart, or, it lacks the will to win. There are some horses that aren't game. But, in my opinion, most raceway horses are actually trying their hardest to win.

The reason why they don't win is because they're facing faster horses. So if you see a horse that has final times that are consistently faster than the other horses in the race, the horse should be tough to beat. This is especially true if the horse did not merely follow along in its recent races, but was active in the flow of the action.

Winning tickets with six correct selections will share in 75% of the daily net pool, and 100% of the carryover. Ticket holders with five correct selections share in 25% of the daily net pool.

Hannelore Hanover, Filibuster Hanover lead Saturday card at Big M

Hannelore Hanover is ready to step out. Filibuster Hanover might be ready to step up.

Returning Horse of the Year Award-winner Hannelore Hanover makes her seasonal debut Saturday (May 5) at the Meadowlands Racetrack when she faces 11 male rivals in the Arthur J. Cutler Memorial for older trotters. Filibuster Hanover, last year's Little Brown Jug winner, also makes his 2018 bow at the Big M, taking on 10 foes in the first of two divisions of the Graduate Series for 4-year-old male pacers.

Yannick Gingras will drive the Ron Burke trainees in their respective races, which will be contested at 1-1/8 miles because the fields exceeded 10 horses. First race post time is 7:15 p.m. (EDT). The \$182,500 Cutler is race No. 7 while the \$50,000 Graduate divisions are races six and nine.

CHRB Rule No. 1699

(b) A horse shall not interfere with or cause any other horse to lose stride, ground or position in a part of the race where the horse loses the opportunity to place where it might be reasonably expected to finish.

(c) A horse which interferes with another and thereby causes any other horse to lose stride, ground or position, when such other horse is not at fault and when such interference occurs in a part of the race where the horse interfered with loses the opportunity to place where it might, in the opinion of the Stewards, be reasonably expected to finish, may be disqualified and placed behind the horse so interfered with.

Race 6 News

Hannelore Hanover won 10 of 17 races last year, finished second five times, and earned \$1.04 million for owners Burke Racing Stable, the Weaver Brusce mi partnership, Frank Baldachino, and J&T Silva Stables. For her career, the daughter of Swan For All out of High Sobriety has won 36 of 58 races and \$2.47 million.

The 6-year-old female trotter enters the Cutler off two wins in qualifiers, the first in 1:53.2 and the most recent in 1:52.2. She will start the Cutler from post 12, the trailing position behind Mambo Lindy in post No. 2.

"It's a 12-horse field at a mile and an eighth, so it's not the ideal scenario for a first start," said Gingras, who was the 2017 Driver of the Year. "But everyone is in the same boat. Both of her qualifiers were strong and I feel like she's ready for a good mile."

Hannelore Hanover defeated male rivals multiple times last year, most notably in the finals of the Breeders Crown Open Trot and Maple Leaf Trot, as well

STARTER'S RULES

1728. Starter's Control. The starter shall have control over the horses from the formation of the parade until he gives the word 'go.' The starter shall report to the stewards any misconduct or violation on the part of the driver and may order any unmanageable or disabled horse declared (scratched) from the race with the concurrence of the stewards.

1729. Starting the race. The starter shall bring the horses to the starting gate as near one-quarter of a mile from the starting point as the track may permit, and shall endeavor to get all horses away in position and on gait. If a horse refuses to come to the gate, is unmanageable or liable to cause an accident or injury to any other horse or driver, it may be declared and all monies wagered on that horse shall be refunded.

1730. Recalls. The starter may sound a recall for only the following reasons: 1-A horse scored ahead of the gate; 2- There is interference prior to the word 'go' being given; 3-A horse has broken equipment; 4-A horse falls prior to the word 'go' being given. There shall be no recall after the word 'go' is given and any horse, regardless of his position or an accident, shall be deemed a starter from the time he entered into the starter's control unless dismissed.

As happy as Gingras is about Hannelore Hanover's return, he is also excited to see what Filibuster Hanover can do this season. Filibuster Hanover won five of 20 races last year and earned \$724,029. His wins included the Little Brown Jug and a division of the Bluegrass Stakes. He finished second in the Monument Circle, Matron, and Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship.

Filibuster Hanover enters his Graduate division off two qualifiers. He finished second to Blood Line in 1:51.1 in his first outing, then exploded for a 1:49.3 win in his most recent effort, pacing his final quarter-mile in :25.2.

"The horse has always had super ability," Gingras said. "When he trained down as a 2-year-old, Ronnie and I both agreed he was our favorite of the whole pack.

It just took a long time for him to get rolling. I think he's matured into a really good horse. He's nice to drive, he's straight, and

C.H.R.B. BREAKING RULES

1722. Breaking. Should any horse break from its gait in either trotting or pacing, the driver shall:

(a) Where clearance exists, take such horse to the outside.

(b) Attempt to pull the horse to its gait.

(c) Lose ground.

1723. Lapped-on Break. The driver of a horse which has broken from its gait who has complied with the breaking rule shall not be set back unless a contending horse on his gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish.
