Races honor memory Of Goudreau, Lighthill

(Continued from Page One)

He came back East to compete at Roosevelt and Yonkers and won many major stakes in New York, including the \$200,000 George Morton Levy Pace in 1979 in track-record time at Roosevelt. He drove at the Meadowlands and was once again successful. He competed there against another up-and-coming driver named John Campbell as well as a familiar face from home in Ray Remmen.

It was 1981 that proved Goudreau's best season. He competed in both the Hambletonian (with Santa Ana) and the Little Brown Jug (with Freedom Fella). He won 170 races and earned \$2.3 million in purses that year. These were gaudy numbers for the then 33-year-old.

During his career he was responsible for the success of such horses as Genghis Khan p,1:51 4/5 (\$983,467), Try Scotch p,1:54 3/5 (\$956,770), Tijuana Taxi p,1:54 3/5 (\$784,306), Apollo's Way p,1:56 (\$502,536), Freedom Fella p,1:54 4/5 (\$491,790), Tender Loving Care p,1:52 4/5 (\$327,822) and the trotter Superman 1:58 1/5(\$140,794).

In his short career he amassed 2,291 wins and \$12,942,265 in purse money. At the time of his death he was eighth in the North American driver standings.

He was inducted in the Canadian Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 1983.

The Joe Lighthill Trot is named for the outstanding driver/trainer who was a mainstay in California for decades and passed away at the age of 78 in 2006.

Mr. Lighthill, who began his career in the mid-1940s, drove 2,272 winners for purse earnings just shy of \$7 million and reined and/or trained some of the best performers of their generation.

Included in that illustrious group were Meadow Skipper, Countess Adios, Tender Loving Care, Hickory Pride, Peter Lobell, Try Scotch and BC Count.

"Joe was the consummate horseman and a good friend," said Vickie Desomer. "Time and time again Steve and I relied on him to get our young, green horses safely around the track and he always did just that."

"He was truly one of the greats, not just in California, but across the nation."

PYLON RULE

(For Horses Racing Without Interference)

1. Going inside two (2) pylons and lapped-on at the finish: The offending horse will be disqualified and placed behind any lapped-on horses at the wire.
2. Going inside three (3) or more consecutive pylons: The offending horse will be disqualified and placed last.
3. If an unfair advantage is gained by going inside, over, or in-between one or more pylons in order to pass another competitor: The offending horse will be disqualified.

The steward's discretion applies to all placement.

CHRB Rule No. 1699

(b) A horse shall not interfere with or cause any other horse to lose stride, ground or position in a part of the race where the horse loses the opportunity to place where it might be reasonably expected to finish.

(c) A horse which interferes with another and thereby causes any other horse to lose stride, ground or position, when such other horse is not at fault and when such interference occurs in a part of the race where the horse interfered with loses the opportunity to place where it might, in the opinion of the Stewards, be reasonably expected to finish, may be disqualified and placed behind the horse so interfered with.

STARTER'S RULES

1728. Starter's Control. The starter shall have control over the horses from the formation of the parade until he gives the word 'go.' The starter shall report to the stewards any misconduct or violation on the part of the driver and may order any unmanageable or disabled horse declared (scratched) from the race with the concurrence of the stewards.

1729. Starting the race. The starter shall bring the horses to the starting gate as near one-quarter of a mile from the starting point as the track may permit, and shall endeavor to get all horses away in position and on gait. If a horse refuses to come to the gate, is unmanageable or liable to cause an accident or injury to any other horse or driver, it may be declared and all monies wagered on that horse shall be refunded.

1730. Recalls. The starter may sound a recall for only the following reasons: 1-A horse scored ahead of the gate; 2- There is interference prior to the word 'go' being given; 3-A horse has broken equipment; 4-A horse falls prior to the word 'go' being given. There shall be no recall after the word 'go' is given and any horse, regardless of his position or an accident, shall be deemed a starter from the time he entered into the starter's control unless dismissed.
